Cliff & Veronica were, for many years, the wardens at Hartington Hall Youth Hostel. In the 1970s they bought Grove House in Elkstones, which was their home until they moved in 2011 to live closer to their children. Cliff died in 2012 but will be buried with Veronica so they will be together again in their beloved Elkstones, where they were a big part of the village for so long.
