CARDIAC ARREST ONLY RESPONSE SCHEME (Numbers PLUS)

As a group of Community First Responders (CFRs) typically we will have someone on duty covering every day of the month throughout the year. However, we recognise that there can be periods of time when no one is on duty (especially throughout the night). We have therefore decided to enhance our response/support to the community by setting up a Cardiac Arrest Only Response Scheme in partnership with West Midlands Ambulance Service (WMAS). The CFRs within WACFR have agreed to be on call for 24 hours a day 7 days a week throughout the year and, if available, respond and assist with a *Sudden Cardiac Arrest* in the community. There are currently 10 CFRs within WACFR and if a CFR was unavailable the system will automatically call the next person(s) on the list. This scheme would be automatically activated by a member of the public making a '999' call to report the cardiac arrest in order to notify the ambulance service.

Please note: The CFR arriving would probably be in their own car and not in uniform.

The above scheme is in addition to our normal CFR role and rest assured that this service will continue as it always has done. If you have any questions about the above scheme, please contact either Denise or Mike as per the details below.

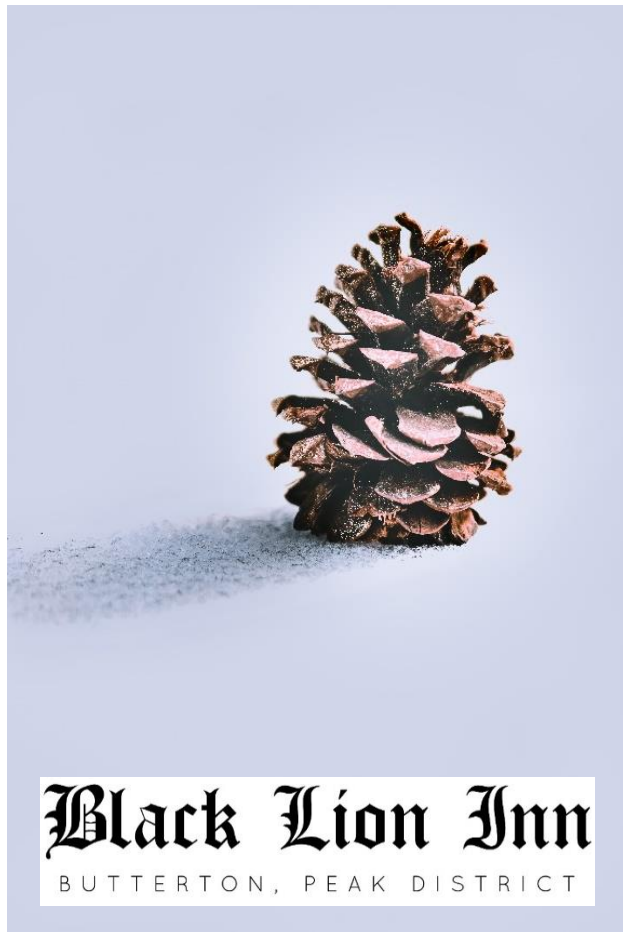

Message From the Bus Shelter



The Bus Shelter Shop has started its hibernation. We plan to open again (all being well) in Spring 2023. Please do not leave anything in the Bus Shelter in the meantime. If you have books or bric-a-brac to donate, please consider storing them for a few months, so we can start again with full shelves.

During the autumn the Shelter project was **The Church Tower Repair Fund**. We have raised **£1,182**, which is an amazing result. **THANK YOU TO EVERYONE** who has contributed.

Many villagers take the view that the church is a village asset, and have asked that the funds raised will be directed exclusively to the

repairs and do not contribute to Church of England coffers. The PCC has recognised this and have opened an independent bank account for this purpose, with the money ring-fenced for the project. The donation from the Shelter makes a significant boost to getting work started to fix the leak in the church spire. If anyone would like to contribute to the scheme, please get in touch with us, or Maggie Risby who is clerk to the Parish Council. The the grand total donated by the Bus Shelter this year is a staggering **£3,795**. The money has gone to the projects selected by you.

The Bus Shelter guardians wish everyone the best for the upcoming winter, and look forward to re-opening in 2023. In the meantime -

Events this Month (and Beyond)

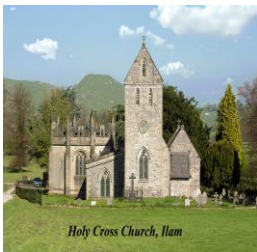
Hope the weather is nice for the Elkstones Carol Singers who will be out "on the Town" on Friday, 16th December, collecting money probably for Homeless People.
