It has been created by Sir Jony Ive, known for his innovative designs of Apple gadgets, including the iPhone. This is a more traditional image, with flowers forming the shape of the St Edward's crown which will be used in the coronation. "The design was inspired by King Charles's love of the planet, nature, and his deep concern for the natural world" says Sir Jony. The logo features a rose, thistle, daffodil and shamrock - emblems from across the United Kingdom.
